Plan for next period:

- Draw and develop activities to foster a broader community engagement and participation in the LA Strategy's development.
- Aggressively and continuously explore funding opportunities.
- Design and perform the co-organisation and co-execution of events [\(in association with the education committee\)](#) like
- Act as an intermediary in facilitating the mobilisation of local volunteers, resources, and partnerships to support projects and activities approved by the Board (*Ongoing* under the [Creative Commons Venezuela Chapter](#)).
- Some specific Activities:
 - Video content creation
 - Training sessions (1 or 2-day workshop) for content creation for members.
- Coordinate outreach activities with the Education Committee
- Carry out a (widely advertised) poll in 2025 to understand the demographics of the HECAP LA community (in terms of location, job position, fields, etc.), as well as the needs and expectations of the community. Also, as a means of publicizing the association.

- Use LAA-HECAP channels to promote the school/activities and, at the same time, promote the association during these activities.
- LAA-HECAP has produced a list of all HECAP experiments and collaborations with LA membership. Reach out to these collaborations to publicize LAA-HECAP and call for participation in the association. Reach out to astrophysics/cosmology experiments that have a strong presence in LA but are normally restricted to the astronomy framework, not HEP (e.g., Rubin LSST).
- Establish an LAA-HECAP prize (could have categories for senior researchers, early career researchers, and students). The prize could be funding to attend and present the research work at the SILAF AE meetings (or another meeting connected to LAA-HECAP).

JEDI COMMITTEE:

Plan for next period:

- In collaboration with the Statistics and Community Engagement Committees, study the representation of the LA community in the Association. Based on the findings of this study, then:
 - Seek to attract new members to ensure the Association represents the LA community as closely as possible.
 - Understand each region's predominant problems/difficulties in order to establish the appropriate course of action to solve them in the future.
- Create guidelines to ensure accessibility is guaranteed in all activities of the Association, e.g. information on which factors should be considered by conference organizers to assure persons with physical limitations can participate, recommendations to make online meetings more accessible to people with limited hearing, etc.
- Organize round-table/town-hall style virtual gatherings to discuss topics relevant to JEDI with expert advice. Frequency: every 2 months approximately. Proposed topics include:
 - Accessibility
 - Gender equality
 - Work-life balance
 - etc
- Liaise with the other Committees in the Association to assure that the objectives of JEDI are taken into account in their activities, and provide advice when needed.
