# Open Issues on heavy-ion physics Symposium in honor of Guy Paic

1<sup>st</sup> - 2<sup>nd</sup> December 2012 Puebla City, Mexico

The symposium will take place in Hotel Camino Real in the City of Puebla, Mexico.

Puebla City was founded with the name *Puebla de los Angeles* in 1531. Since 1862 its official name is *Heroica Puebla de Zaragoza*, and is the capital of the Mexican state of Puebla. The downtown area is ideal for site seeing on foot.

In Puebla you can have the opportunity to admire many colonial treasures including buildings that make use of ornamental tiles called *Talavera* and numerous colonial churches. Puebla's historic center was granted UNESCO world heritage status in 1987. The cathedral, built between 1552 and 1649, is one of the finest in Mexico. The old city theater constructed in 1790 is said to be the oldest in the Americas. Puebla is the birthplace of some of the best well known dishes of Mexican's cuisine such as *mole poblano* and *chiles en nogada*. Not far from the city one can visit some fine archaeological sites such as Cholula and Cacaxtla built by the Olmeca-Xicalanca culture.

## TRAVEL

Although Puebla is an international tourist destination with its own airport, participants from abroad are advised to make arrangements to arrive to Mexico City International Airport.

A 30 minutes coach service runs from Mexico City International Airport to Puebla City. Its cost is about 210 MXN one way (around 13 EUR). Be aware that the ticket can be bought only in cash and in Mexican pesos. At the airport look for the "Estrella Roja" counter <a href="http://www.estrellaroja.com.mx">http://www.estrellaroja.com.mx</a> located at the international arrival section, second floor. The journey takes no more than 2 hours and ends in Puebla bus station terminal "4 Poniente". From there you can take a taxi to your hotel (about 50 MXN one way).
